Conditions for use - All persons participating in this static display must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing.
2. be members of the Halton Hills Model Flying Club, or an invited guest of Halton Hills Model Flying Club, and
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

Event:

Halton Hills Model Aircraft Flying Club (HHMFC) participation in this open to the public event consists of an approximately 20' wide x 40' deep outdoor area with a static display of various RC aircraft and a RC flight simulator, staffed by HHMFC members.

Persons staffing the HHMFC exhibit will be members in good standing of both MAAC and the HHMFC.

The Brampton Flight Centre will provide the use of an electrical outlet; the HHMFC will provide its own extensions and site equipment.

Brampton Flight Centre personnel will direct club members staffing the exhibit to the appropriate parking area.

A copy the rules or requirements for this event shall be posted at the exhibit.

### **Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules**

1. This event is a static display of various RPAS and operation of RC Flight simulator only, staffed by HHMFC members. The event is open to the public.
2. There is no flying or operation of any model permitted at this site. The Club will only permit static displays of inoperable model airplanes. The model is not allowed to be operated in any way.
3. All models on display will be unpowered without batteries (flight batteries, ignition batteries and/or propulsion batteries) installed. All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered model.
4. All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable. Propulsion batteries must be removed or dis-connected.
5. Ground operation is permitted for purposes such as demonstrating flight controls, retracts, lights etc. if propellers are removed, or the motor is disconnected from its power supply.
6. The HHMFC exhibition area consists of an approximately 20' wide x 40' deep roped off outdoor area with shade canopies, tables, and an electrical supply.
  - a. The models will always be out of reach of bystanders with club members in attendance. At no time will any model, electric or otherwise, propulsion system be energized during the display.
  - b. Only HHMFC members will be permitted to handle any models on display at this event.
  - c. No public or bystanders are permitted within the roped off exhibition area.
  - d. Club members staffing the exhibit shall monitor the public and bystanders to assure they remain outside the roped of area.
  - e. When any member or other person spots a person or bystander that might come into the modeling area unsafely, they are approach the bystander advise them that they may not enter the roped off area, or to leave the roped off area, as applicable,
7. Members of the public will be allowed to operate RC Flight Simulators such as Realflight or similar. All model aircraft must stay within the designated display area during the event.

## Emergency or safety procedures

In the event of an emergency, phone 911 and the Brampton Flight Centre main desk 905-838-1400, Front Desk.

1. A suitable fire extinguisher must be available.
2. A small first aid kit must be available while models are displayed.
3. Emergency Procedures and location of emergency equipment will be posted at the venue.
4. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at Halton Hills Model Flying Club/ Brampton Flight Centre Airport Day modelling site.
5. The Club will review these rules at least once a year.
