Moose Jaw Radio Control Aircraft Club *have been given permission to conduct MAAC modelling activities indoors and fully understand and agree any permission granted applies to indoor activities **only** – no exceptions*

Purpose: Model Display, Flight Simulator participation, Power Point Presentation and MJRC Club Members meet and greet to help generate membership within Our MJRC Club

Conditions for use - All people participating in the static display site must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing.
2. be members of the **MOOSE JAW RADIO CONTROL AIRCRAFT CLUB**, or an invited guest of **MOOSE JAW RADIO CONTROL AIRCRAFT CLUB** and
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

The event is open to the public.

A copy of these rules must be present during the display, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device).

- All models must remain within the designated indoor display area.
- Only club members may access the display area.
- Public visitors must remain outside the designated display area.

Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

1. This event is a static display only. No model aircraft will be operated at this event.
2. There is no flying permitted at this site. The Club will only permit the static displays of inoperable model airplanes. The model is not allowed to be operated in any way.
3. No LiPo batteries are to be taken on site, including transmitter batteries.
4. Models on display will be unpowered, no batteries will be allowed on site. All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered models.
5. All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable. Any complete aircraft must have the propeller(s) removed. Propulsion batteries must be disconnected.
6. All models will be contained in a display out of reach of bystanders with club members in attendance. At no time will any model, electric or otherwise be powered up during the display.
7. Only club members will be allowed inside the designated display area.
8. No model aircraft will be allowed outside the designated display area.

Emergency or safety procedures

1. A suitable fire extinguisher must be available.
2. A small first aid kit must be available while models are displayed.
3. Emergency procedures: **Call 911**
 - Locations of emergency equipment, including fire extinguishers, and exits are posted in the building.
 - A suitable fire extinguisher and small first aid kit must be available while models are displayed.
4. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this modelling site.
5. These rules will be reviewed by the club annually or prior to the next display at this site.
