Preferential rwy: Btwn 04-12Z†, all acft shall, when aprt and wx conditions permitting, land on Rwy 24R and take-off Rwy 06L.

Departure: 24L rstd to single engine acft having a GTOW of less than 5000 lbs. Rwy 24L and 24R climb rwy hdg to 1100 ASL BPOC or in the circuit. All VFR acft leaving the CZ, climb to not above 1100 ASL or as assigned by ATC.

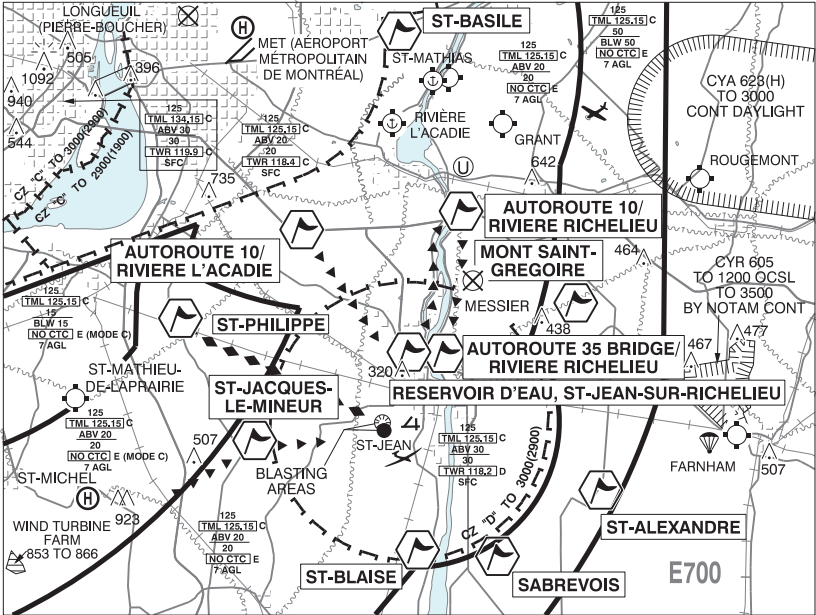
