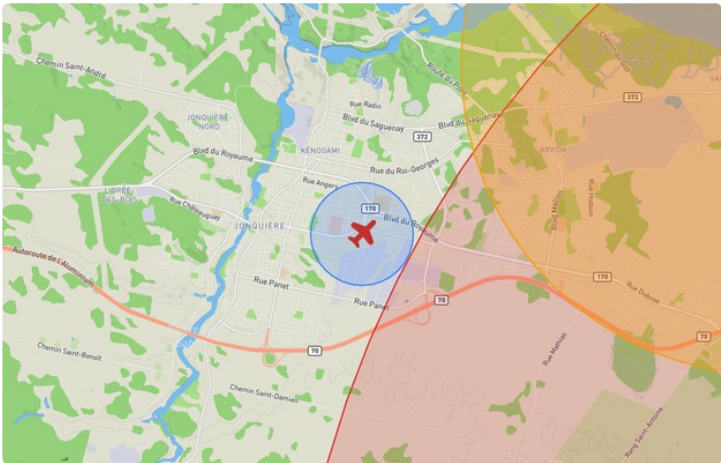

All VFR acft wishing to penetrate Bagotville's class D airspace and who have not filed a Flt Pln with arr or dep to/fr Bagotville TCA or St-Honoré can obtain a transponder code in flt on freq 121.2 before penetrating Bagotville's class D airspace or by phone at the following number 1-888-813-8508. 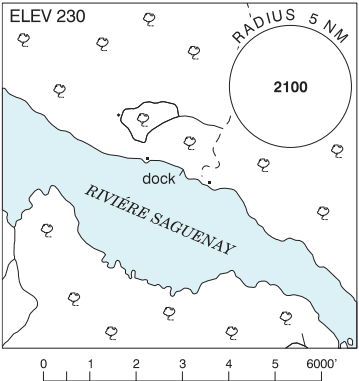
